Humility

Humility is an obvious theme from our readings this Sunday. This virtue is, no doubt, one of the most difficult to cultivate while also being the most repulsive to our modern-day sensibilities. Even many of the ancient philosophers who had a great deal of insightful things to say about virtue thought very little of humility. They oftentimes associated it with weakness and small-mindedness. Such is not our Christian understanding. Here is a quote from our first reading:

“Conduct your affairs with humility,
and you will be loved more than a giver of
gifts.

Humble yourself the more, the greater you
are,
and you will find favor with God.”

Understanding the thrust of this instruction from the *Book of Sirach*, the great intellectuals and saints within our tradition typically associate the virtue of humility with strength and courage. Indeed, humility is a tremendously difficult virtue to acquire. It requires that I find my deepest sense of worth beyond the cravings of my own ego. “What I can do,” “what I have done,” and “what other people think about me” are all secondary considerations to “Who I am.”

When I reflect deeply upon “Who I am,” I must admit that I did not make myself.

“What have you that you did not receive?” says Saint Paul in his *First Letter to the Corinthians*.

To be humble, then, is to recognize that the core of who I am is created out of God's abundant love. Such an insight leads me to conclude (1) that I am good, (2) that such goodness goes deeper than anything I have or can do, and (3) that I need not jostle with my peers for the most honorable seat at the banquet of self-aggrandizement. Living out these conclusions grants me the freedom that no amount of worldly goods and accomplishments could ever earn for me.

This was the attitude of Mary who infamously declared, “My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord. My spirit rejoiced in God my Savior, for He has looked with favor on His lowly servant.” Her true strength and greatness consisted in being humble enough to allow God to work through her. May we do our best to follow her example. To that end, I've inserted a popular prayer called the *Litany of Humility* on the back page of this bulletin which can serve as an aid for us to live out of the truth of our being.
