This Wednesday we will celebrate one of our Church's most complicated figures in the Gospel, that being Saint Matthew, apostle and evangelist. His story related in the Gospel is terse: "As Jesus passed by, He saw a man named Matthew sitting at the customs post. He said to him, "Follow me." And he got up and followed him."

As quick as the Biblical narration of Matthew's conversion is, the spiritual and artistic tradition of the Church has unsparingly reflected upon it. One such example is the painting above which captures well the complexity of Matthew's calling.

Matthew was anything but perfect when Christ called him. Being a tax-collector, he had a career that his own Jewish values found to be morally reprehensible. Not only did he work for the tyrannical Roman State, but he would have also taken extra money from the Jews for his own well-being. He certainly knew better as his particular Gospel is widely considered to reveal the deepest understanding of Jewish law and custom, but such an understanding did little to impact his disgraceful lifestyle. All of this indicates that he did nothing to earn Christ's calling.

But there Matthew is at his post counting his money when Christ enters his life and calls him. So sudden is this calling that Matthew is struck dumbfounded, lost in the re-creative gaze of Christ, pointing unassuredly to himself with his left hand while still grasping coins in his right. This painting captures well the moment of conversion. "Lord, You seriously want me? Do I really have to let go?"

Matthew ultimately allowed the light of grace to touch him. That same light is still shining today. It is extended by the Father, through the Hands of Christ and the Church (notice Peter also pointing to Matthew), and it calls us forward. It is a light that the world cannot offer (notice how it isn't coming from the widow). It's beautiful. It's purifying. And it's terrifying. It rests on each of our faces demanding a response. Are we willing, like Matthew, to let go and use our hands to transmit it?

NEW articles are collected and are taken to the veteran facilities in Hot Springs. Gift shops are set up there and residents of both facilities individually choose gifts for their families and loved ones. With volunteer assistance, these articles are wrapped and distributed or mailed at no expense to the veteran.

Some items may also be gifted to the veterans themselves who do not regularly have visitors or receive gifts. Clothing, books, toys, games, and household goods are all good gifts. Please do NOT send makeup or perfume. Gift cards redeemable at national chains are accepted and make excellent gifts that are easy to mail. Handmade items are always appreciated. Gift wrap and cards are also always appreciated. Donations of cash may also be sent and are used for postage or to purchase additional gifts. Last year our generous community sent 577 gifts valued at over \$7,000 as well as \$78 worth of wrapping supplies.

Please remember that many gifts must be mailed, so please do NOT choose heavy, bulky, or glass items. Articles should be NEW but not too expensive. They should be something that you yourself would give as a gift or like to receive. Since we are asked to list the value of gifts, please leave any price tags attached (they are removed before gifts are sent to Hot Springs). Hill City and other area residents, businesses and the American Legion have been wonderful in their support of this project. Gifts may be dropped off at the Hill City Center, in the marked boxes at Community Lutheran Church, Little White Church and St. Rose of Lima. Gifts will be collected until Monday, October 17, when they will be organized to reach Hot Springs in time for the Christmas Gift Shop. Volunteers in Hot Springs will help the veterans choose, wrap and send gifts beginning in early November.
